New One stop clinic

When a patients attends for a face to face appointment with a doctor the doctor will address the problem the patient has attended for and then if the patient has any other issues that can be dealt with by the treatment room they will be booked into the clinic there and then, i.e blood test needed, bp review, Rheumatoid arthritis review etc.
